The <u>2016 Voluntary Sector and Volunteering Research Conference</u> will be held on 8-9th September at the <u>Nottingham Conference Centre</u>. This annual conference is organized jointly by <u>NCVO</u>, the <u>Voluntary Sector Studies Network</u> (VSSN) and the <u>Institute for Volunteering Research</u> (IVR).

It is an opportunity for academics, policy makers and practitioners to share **new and emerging research and network** across different contexts, sectors, and different parts of **the UK and internationally**. The conference will gather contributions from the UK, South Africa, Nigeria, the United States and Canada.

Over two days, there will be a mix of plenary sessions, parallel paper sessions and panel sessions. Specific sessions for new researchers will run alongside the main conference programme. <u>Campbell Robb</u>, Chief Executive of <u>Shelter</u>, will be the keynote speaker.

The themes for this year's conference are:

- civil society and democracy: ongoing challenges and opportunities
- · volunteering and participation: present and future
- new methods, new data: what are the opportunities and challenges presented in research data and methodology on the sector?
- grassroots voluntary activity: past perspectives and new forms
- navigating the **funding** landscape: funding, fundraising and philanthropy
- voluntary sector governance and management: new challenges and responses
- advancing theoretical debates: old ideas, new directions
- what's new? Historical perspectives on the voluntary sector and voluntary action
- the role of the voluntary sector in a new world of public services

A draft version of the programme is already available. Early bird bookings are open until 17.00 on 22 July 2016.
