

Musicians, refugees and communities are coming together to recognise the things that unite them.

'[Give a Home](#)' is a first-of-its-kind global day of **live music events** taking place in **people's homes**, in which **1,000 musicians** will perform at over **300 concerts** in more than **200 cities** globally. The event takes place on **20th September**, and will bring together musicians, refugees, and music fans in the aim of uniting people to **welcome refugees**.

This initiative, promoted by [Amnesty International](#) and [Sofar](#), is, in fact, an unprecedented global celebration of music and community and a chance for people to give support to refugees.

The National, Ed Sheeran, Bastille, James Morrison, Daughter, Local Natives and **The Fratellis** are some of the important artists who will take part in this campaign.

How can I apply for the tickets?

Fans will have an opportunity to **win up to two tickets** to [the act of their choice](#). They are encouraged to **make a donation** which will go to [Amnesty International](#) in order to combat the **global refugee crisis**.

The lucky ones will receive a notification between 10th and 17th September.
