The aim is to denounce the serious violation occurring in many countries of the basic rights of LGBTI people, who can seek asylum in Spain.

<u>Do not hide: The right to asylum and LGBTI</u> persecution' is an initiative launched by the <u>Catalan Commission for Refugee Aid (CCAR)</u>, calling into question that **migration** is a voluntary move, as is often portrayed. The initiative seeks to open a discussion on the different forms of **persecution**, human rights **violations** and types of protection.

This webpage provides **data** on the situation lived by the LGBTI community around the world and **testimonials** of people who have been forced to seek refuge after suffering **violence**, **abuse**, **severe discrimination and criminalization**.

The page also provides **information on the right to asylum**, a **glossary** that can help better understanding some concepts and **recommendations** on what can be done when encountering certain situations.
