Four years from the celebration of the II International Congress on Families and Disability, [Dincat](#), [Plena Inclusión](#) and the [FPCEE de la Universitat Ramon Llull \(URL\)](#), organise the **III International Congress on Family and Disability. Social skills in childhood: An urgent challenge.**

The Congress will take place in Barcelona, in the Faculty of Psychology of Blanquerna (Universitat Ramon Llull), from May 31 to June 1.

The aim of the congress is to know and spread experiences focused on promoting interactions between peers, among children with developmental disorders in school and family contexts, from practices based on evidence and contrasted experiences in schools and families.
