The **eight main fields of action** identified in the 2010-2018 EU Youth Strategy are **education and training, employment and entrepreneurship, health and well-being, participation, voluntary activities, social inclusion, youth and the world, and creativity and culture**.

The main source of information consists of official documents originating from national top-level authorities in the youth field and **studies, surveys, analyses or assessments** conducted directly by public authorities or commissioned to research centres and experts.
